Rich:

We have been discussing the draft report for the Lecture Hall Renovations with all interested faculty and have had extensive conversations with Ed Gyurisin from Media Services. Based on all this input, we have finally settled on the "best" design for the Wet Chemistry Benches - and these are only minor changes (I think) from our draft designs.

In Lec Hall 12, the big hall, make one of the two wet chem benches permanently installed with all services and make the other one on wheels, movable, with no services. This gives us the maximum flexibility for room use and maximum wet chemistry desktop space. The movable one should look identical to the permanently installed one. The permanently installed one should be 8-foot long and the "layout" of the three benches should be as shown in the draft document.

In 12A and 12B, the wet chemistry bench should be 6-foot long and contain all the services. One movable, wheeled second wet chem bench, without any services should be provided (6 or 8 ft long?) that could be wheeled into 12A or 12B as needed.

You can see what we are suggesting - provide two movable wet chemistry benches that can be used in 12A, 12, or 12B as necessary and have only one fixed wet chem bench in each lecture hall.

Just a reminder, the wet chem bench is located to the "inside" wall of 12A and 12B.

I believe these are the final changes to our first draft - and I believe they simplify what we wanted with respect to the earlier drafts of our report. As ever, don't hesitate to contact me if you have questions.
