With the lack of chalkboard space, some of my colleagues are having a problem in CSC-12. The overhead and its large screen is great - everybody likes that. But essentially we need a "second" such setup in CSC-12 immediately.

It seems to me that since the data projector is there, and the bulkhead is there to project on, all we need is a "copy stand". Any chance we can have one temporarily installed immediately. If necessary for security purposes, we can lock it in the Chem Prep area and just have an instructor pull it out when needed. The advantage of doing this is that it is also part of our "permanent AV" approach to media use in CSC-12.
